

# UPDATED ANNOUNCEMENT ON TEACHING AND LEARNING IN SEMESTER 2/2021: RANGSIT UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE ON COVID-19 PREVENTION AND SAFETY MEASURES

Due to the impact of Omicron variant and the Thai government measures to restore mandatory quarantine for visitors entering the country from overseas, Rangsit University International College (RIC) is releasing an updated Announcement on Teaching and Learning in Semester 2/2021.

Updated protocols for Teaching and Learning in Semester 2/2021:

## a. On-Site Classes:

On-site classes will run as planned for students who are in Thailand. The students and lecturers of the on-site classes must be fully-vaccinated. And for those students who are in the process of re-entry into Thailand, they will be allowed to study online by joining the real time onsite classes from January 10 to 29, 2022. And from January 31, 2022 onwards all the following classes in item a will be completely onsite.

The on-site classes include:

- Major courses include IB, Comm. Arts and MIDB
- General Education (GE) courses for Section 100

#### **b.** Online Classes:

RIC students wishing to enroll in online classes will be offered for certain sections. The online classes include:

- Foundation Courses (Plan A, Plan B and 3GE Classes) for Section 208 and 209
- General Education (GE) courses for Section 101

## c. Hybrid Classes:

For ICT classes, all the students will enroll in hybrid class, and all students and lecturers must be fully-vaccinated.

- Students must decide on the subjects or sections they plan to take when registering for 2/2021 semester. We do not allow students to switch from onsite to online classes once the semester begins.
